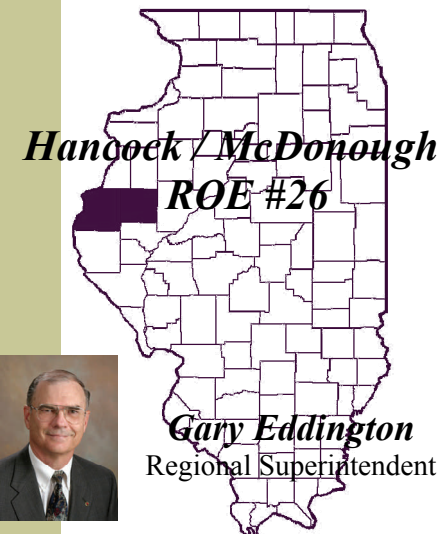

SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE HANCOCK/MCDONOUGH ROE . . .

- ☞ Operates as a liaison to the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE)
- ☞ Monitors the educational standards of County teachers and schools
- ☞ Provides Paraprofessional Testing once a month
- ☞ Oversees County truancy activities
- ☞ Inspects County school properties for life safety compliance
- ☞ Provides GED testing and services
- ☞ Operates the Regional Safe School Program in Hancock and McDonough County
- ☞ Helps teachers and administrators obtain their certificates
- ☞ Provides a customized list of substitute teachers to each school district on a bi-monthly basis
- ☞ Maintains an up to date listing of teacher vacancies in the two County region
- ☞ Maintains an internet web page of resources for educators, parents, and interested citizens
- ☞ Schedules initial training courses and refresher courses for school bus drivers
- ☞ Conducts official state compliance visitation of each district every 4 years
- ☞ Partners with Adams/Pike Counties Regional Office of Education in forming the Professional Development Alliance (PDA), which provides training, workshops, seminars, and graduate courses for educators

Annually

The Hancock/McDonough region registers 900 active and non-active teachers certificates.

Over 2000 teachers have participated in various workshops through professional development of West Central 4.

Approximately 180 bus drivers were trained through refresher courses and 40 bus drivers participated in the initial classes.

150 individuals completed their GED requirements last year.

35 school buildings received life safety and fire inspections
